Funding is available for leadership, management and project management courses offered through the Cardiff University Open for Business programme, running between 02 February and 31 July 2009.

## Criteria

- The organisation should have 'SME' (small to medium sized enterprise) status
- The organisation must be based in Wales
- Each organisation may have any number of applicants for the funding

## Level of funding

Funding available is for 50% of the course cost for leadership and management courses offered through our Open for Business programme, and 25% of course cost for our Project Management courses.
